

DRAINAGE DISTRICT MINUTES  
DISTRICT MILFORD #32  
MARCH 20, 2018

The Story County Drainage District Trustees met in the Public Meeting Room of the Story County Administration Building in Nevada, IA to consider approval of a bid to replace damaged tile in Drainage District Milford #32. Members present were Rick Sanders, chair, Martin Chitty, and Lauris Olson. Also present were County Engineer Darren Moon and Drainage Clerk Scott Wall.

Sanders called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m. and asked Moon to describe the proposed work.

Moon said the Milford #32 tile at the north end of the district is so shallow that it is being crushed by farm equipment. Moon met twice at the site with Hertz Farm Management and came up with two alternatives. The broken tile could be replaced with plastic pipe but that would require the land owners to agree not to cross the pipe with farm equipment. If concrete pipe is used this would not be an issue. The landowners were not interested in staying off the tile so concrete was selected for the replacement tile. Two companies submitted bids: Jensen Excavating for \$30,000 and Con-Struct for \$26,400 (see attached). Moon recommended selecting the Con-Struct bid. Because both bids are under the \$50,000 limit specified by the Iowa Code no public hearing is necessary to complete this repair.

Chitty moved, seconded by Olson, to accept the bid from Con-Struct for \$26,400. Motion carried unanimously (MCU).

Chitty moved, seconded by Olson, to adjourn. MCU. Meeting adjourned at 9:33 a.m.
