

McFarland Park

Area: 6-acre pond

Fish Species: bluegill, channel catfish, largemouth bass, crappie

***Accessibility:** McFarland Park offers paved trails that have great access to the lake, fishing jetties, and kayak launch.

Peterson Park - West & East

Area: Four gravel pits approximately 31-acres. 3 ponds in west, 1 in east.

Fish species: bluegill, channel catfish, crappie, largemouth bass, bullhead, smallmouth bass

Robison Wildlife Acres

Location: 29490 632nd Ave., Nevada

Area: 1-acre pond

Fish Species: bluegill

South Skunk River

Fish species: channel catfish, bullhead, smallmouth bass, carp, buffalo

Area: 137 acres

Fish Species: Black Crappie, Bluegill, Channel Catfish, Common Carp, Largemouth Bass, Rainbow Trout, Wiper (Hybrid Striped Bass), Yellow Perch
